CORRUPTION has no place in South Africa and government is calling on all citizens to act decisively to end dishonest and fraudulent conduct.

Corruption has taken centre stage in South Africa over the last few months in the wake of allegations of state capture and corruption scandals from private sector.

The allegations created a negative outlook for the country, especially with investors.

In his State of the Nation Address President Ramaphosa said "we must fight corruption, fraud and collusion in the private sector with the same purpose and intensity".

"We must remember that every time someone receives a bribe there is someone who is prepared to pay it. We will make sure that we deal with

both in an effective manner." However government cannot fight corruption alone and is committed to rooting out corruption in all forms in the private and public sector while calling on all citizens to play their part.

Corruption is the abuse of public resources or public power for personal gain.

While the police and other arms of government are at the forefront in the fight against corruption, ordinary South Africans have their own role to play.

Several ongoing investigations and a number of arrests show that government wants

MITSHUXEKO YO TALA leyi MaAfrika-Dzonga ma tiphinaka hayona, ku katsa vaakatiko hinkwavo lava nga na malembe ya 18 kumbe ku tula lava pfumeleriweke ku vhota, yi ikeleriweke eku tikeriweni lokukulu swinene. Hi yi tlangela hi Dzivamisoko lembe hlawana na rihlwana.

Hi n'hweti leyi, siku ri hlawuriwile ku tlangela ku fika ka ntshuxeko na xidemokirasi na ku humelela ka MaAfrika-Dzonga hinkwawo eka ku sukela matimu yo vengana, yo avana na matimu yo vava ku ya eka ku aka vumundzuku byin'we swin'we.

Vuku'uzenzele yi langutisisa nkoka wa siku leri na leswi ri vulaka swona eka hina tanihi MaAfrika-Dzonga.

Hi ti 27 Dzivamisoko 1994, Afrika-Dzonga ri ve na mihlawulo yo sungula ya xidemokirasi ya nkaxihlawuhlauwu. Mfumo lowuntshwa wu hlawuriwile ehansi ka vurhangeri bya mufi Phuresidente Nelson Mandela. Swo tala swi fikeleriwile eka malembe lama nga hundza, kambe ka ha ri na swo tala leswi faneleke ku endliwa ku antswisatiko ra hina na ku cinca vutomi bya MaAfrika-Dzonga hinkwawo.

Dzivamisoko a hi ku langutisisa ntsena laha hi humaka kona tanihi tiko, kambe wu tlhela wu va nkarhi lowu Afrika-Dzonga ri tlangelaka tinhenha na tinhenhakazi ta yona hi ku tirhisa Masagwadinkulu ya Rixaka. Lawa i masagwadi ya xiyimo xa le henhla swinene lawa tiko hi ku tirhisa Phuresidente ya rona, ri nyikaka vaakatiko va rona na vanhu va ndhuma vo huma ematikweni mambe.

Vumbiwa ra Rhiphabuliki ra Afrika-Dzonga

Vumbiwa ri mpfampfarhutiwe hi ku ya hi Kavanyisa ka 5 ka Vumbi-

wa ra nkarhinyana (Nawu wa 200 wa 1993) naswona ri amukeriwile ro sungula hi Huvo ya Vumbiwa hi ti 8 Mudyaxihi 1996. Ri sayiniwile ri va nawu hi ti 10 N'wendzambahala 1996.

Mifungho ya rixaka ya hina

Afrika-Dzonga yi fana yi ri yoxe hi mhaka ya leswaku ha swi kota ku tlangela ku hambanahambana ka hina hi ku tirhisa Mifungho ya Rixaka na Mujeko wa Rixaka, Risimu ra Rixaka ra Afrika-Dzonga na Mfungho wa Vuhosi wa hina.

Mujeko wa Afrika-Dzonga wu fana wu ri woxe. Wu dizayiniwile hi khale ka Murhumiwa wa Mfumo wa Afrika-Dzonga, Fred Brownell, naswona wu tirhisiwe ro sungula hi ti 27 Dzivamisoko 1994.

Mihlovo ya mujeko a yi na nhlamuselo yo kongoma, hikokwalaho a ku na vuyimeri bya misava hinkwayo lebyi nga fambelanisiwaka na mihlovo ya wona.

"V" eka mujeko yi yimela ku hlangana ka swilo swo hambana swa Afrika-Dzonga na ku teka rendzo ro ya emahlweni hi ri na vun'we.
