**W**hen Tumelo Mashigo was born he had little prospect of living a normal life. Shortly after his birth, doctors informed his mother that he had a rare condition called phocomelia and his hands were underdeveloped.

However, living with this condition did not deter Mashigo. Instead it gave him the fighting spirit needed to make something

of his life.

Fast forward to 2017 and Mashigo was announced as the second best performing learner with special needs in the matric class of 2017 in South Africa.

He passed matric with flying colours, achieving three distinctions and being accepted by the University of Pretoria to study Public Management and International Relations.

He said without the assistance of the South Africa

Social Security Agency (Sassa), his dreams would not have come true.

"My mother is unemployed so from a young age I have been getting the disability grant from Sassa, which had such a huge impact on my family," he said.

"The grant helped my mother care for me by buying me food and all the things I required for school."

The 18-year-old from

Tsakane in Gauteng completed his matric at the Muriel Brand School in Brakpan which is an educational facility for learners with special education needs. He was also the school's deputy head boy for 2017.

This was also the school that prepared the confident young man for leadership in the future.

**MAAFRIKA-DZONGA** va fanele ku tiyisisa swinene ku tolvela ku landzelela milawu ya vuhaliseki bya swakudya loko tiko ri langutanile na ntungu wa vuvabyi bya *Listeriosis*.

**N**dzawulo ya Riha-nyo yi vekile tihlo swinene eka ntungu wa vuvabyi bya *Listeriosis*, laha ku nga na 119 wa timhangu tintshwa ta vuvabyi lebyi leti vikiweke ku suka hi ti 5 N'wendzamhala. Nhlayo hinkwayo ya 727 wa timhangu leti tiyisisiweke elaboratari ti vikiwile hi 2017.

Senthara ya Nsivelu na Vu-lawuri bya Vuvabyi yi hlamusela vuvabyi bya *Listeriosis* tanihu vuvabyi byo tika kambe lebyi tshungulekaka na ku siveleka naswona lebyi vangaka hi xitsongwatsongwani xa *Listeria monocytogenes*. Xi kumeka emisaveni, ematini na le swihlahleni. Swakudya swo huma eswiharlhini -ku fana ni nyama na masi, swakudya swa le lwanle na mitshovelo yintshwa yo fana na mihandzu na matsavu swi nga ha tluletiwa ku suka eka swihlovo leswi.

Hambileswi munhu un'wana ni un'wana angaha hlaseriwaka hi *listeriosis*, lava vanga eka nxungeto wukulu wo hlaseriwa

hi vuvabyi lebyi va katsa vana lava va ha ku velekiwaka, vadyuhari, vavasati lava tikeke, na vanhu lava nga na miri leyi tsaneke ni ku hlaseriwa hi mavabyi yo fana na HIV, vuvabyi bya chukele, mfukuzani, vuvabyi bya xivindzi bya nkarhi wo leha kumbe vavabyi lava va nga na vuvabyi bya xivindzi.

Mitlawa leyi khumbekaka ngopfu i ticece-volavo va nga na masiku ya 28 hi vukhale, na vanhu lava nga na malembe ya le xikarhi ka 15 na 49. Mitlawa leyimbirhi yi endla 70 phesente ya timhangu hinkwato.

**N**dzawulo ya Rihanyo ya Gauteng yi angurile eka swilaveko swa vatwisiwakuvava va madzolonga ya timhaka ta swa masangu na rimbewu hi ku simekiwa hi vuntshwa ka Senthara ya Nhlayo ya Sinakekelwe Thuthuzela eXibedhlele xa Thelle Mo-goerane eVosloorus.

Senthara yi lava ku hunguta ku vaviseka emoyeni ka madzolonga ya swa masangu na ku hunguta ku vava kun'wana ka lava ponaka hi ku va nyika nhlayo wa vutshunguri bya xiphurofexinali, vutsundzuxi, na mfikelelo eka valavisisi na vachuchisi lava tinyiketeke, hinkwaswo leswi endhawini yin'we.

Muvulavuleri wa ndzawulo Lesemang Matuka u vule leswaku khale vatwisiwakuvava a va fanele ku famba pfhuka wo leha ku fikelela vukorhokeri lebyi. Xitirhisiwa lexi simekiweke nakambe xi ta

pfuna vanhu ku suka eKatlehong, Thokoza, Vosloorus na tindhawu ta le kusuhi.

"Tanihi ndzawulo, hi lwela ku fikelela rihanyo ro antswa eka hinkwavo hi ku letela ni ku nyika vuswikoti eka vaxitliliniki hi vutshila byo hlawuleka byo pfuna vatwisiwakuvava va vugevenga. Eka malembe yanharhu lama hundzeke, vaxitliliniki va 106 va hetile Dyondzo ya Vatirhi va Nhlayo wa Nhlaselwa timhaka ta swa masangu."

U vule leswaku ndzawulo ya yena yi ta ya emahlweni yi tirhisana na tiNGO na vatirhisani van'wana lava pfunaka hi ku nyika nseketele wa vanhu lava vavisekeke emoyeni hi ku tshikelela ku sivela madzolonga ku nga ri ku nyika nhlayo endzhaku ka loko madzolonga ya humelerile.

Tisenthara ta nhlayo ta Thuthuzela ti tumbuluxiwile ku antswisa matirhelo yo mangala ku pfnyiwa na milandzu yin'wana ya timhaka ta swa masangu. Sweswi va-

### More Matshediso

**A** partnership between the North West Department of Health, the private sector and communities is saving lives, says Health MEC Magome Masike.

MEC Masike says the department has over the years

formed partnerships with various stakeholders to improve the delivery of health services.

"We officially opened a new chemotherapy unit within the Radiation Oncology Unit at Tshepong Hospital Complex in Klerksdorp in 2017. The construction of the unit came as a result of a donation by

the Muslim community," MEC Masike says.

Previously, patients had to be transported to Gauteng to get treated for cancer.

"We are trying by all means to ensure that our people do not have to leave the province to get services," he explains.

Another success story is a

maternity ward worth R6 million that was donated by Anglo Gold Ashanti. It was opened in May 2016 in the Botshabelo Community Health Centre in Stilfontein's Khuma Township.

According to the MEC, about 446 healthy babies have been delivered in the centre since then.

One of the challenges that the department had was a shortage of ambulances but Lonmin came to the rescue with an R11 million donation of 17 ambulances, a patient transporter and two mobile school health units.

Four of the vehicles will be permanently stationed at the Bapong Community Health Centre, while the remainder will service the Bojanala Platinum District Municipality, which includes Kgetlengrivier, Madibeng, Moses Kotane, Moretele and Rustenburg.

Matlou Mokgotho of Mor-

uleng in the Moses Kotane Local Municipality says that although she personally has never had to call an ambulance, she has witnessed how fellow community members struggled to get emergency services because of the unavailability of ambulances.

Lonmin's executive vice president of stakeholder engagement and regulatory affairs, Thandeka Ncube, says it has committed to assisting the department by providing it with the resources that it does not have or cannot afford. She explains that the end goal is to ensure that all residents have access to adequate primary healthcare within their vicinities.

Future Lonmin projects include a forensic mortuary, a community healthcare centre for the Marikana community, and a multipurpose community centre for Majakaneng residents. □
