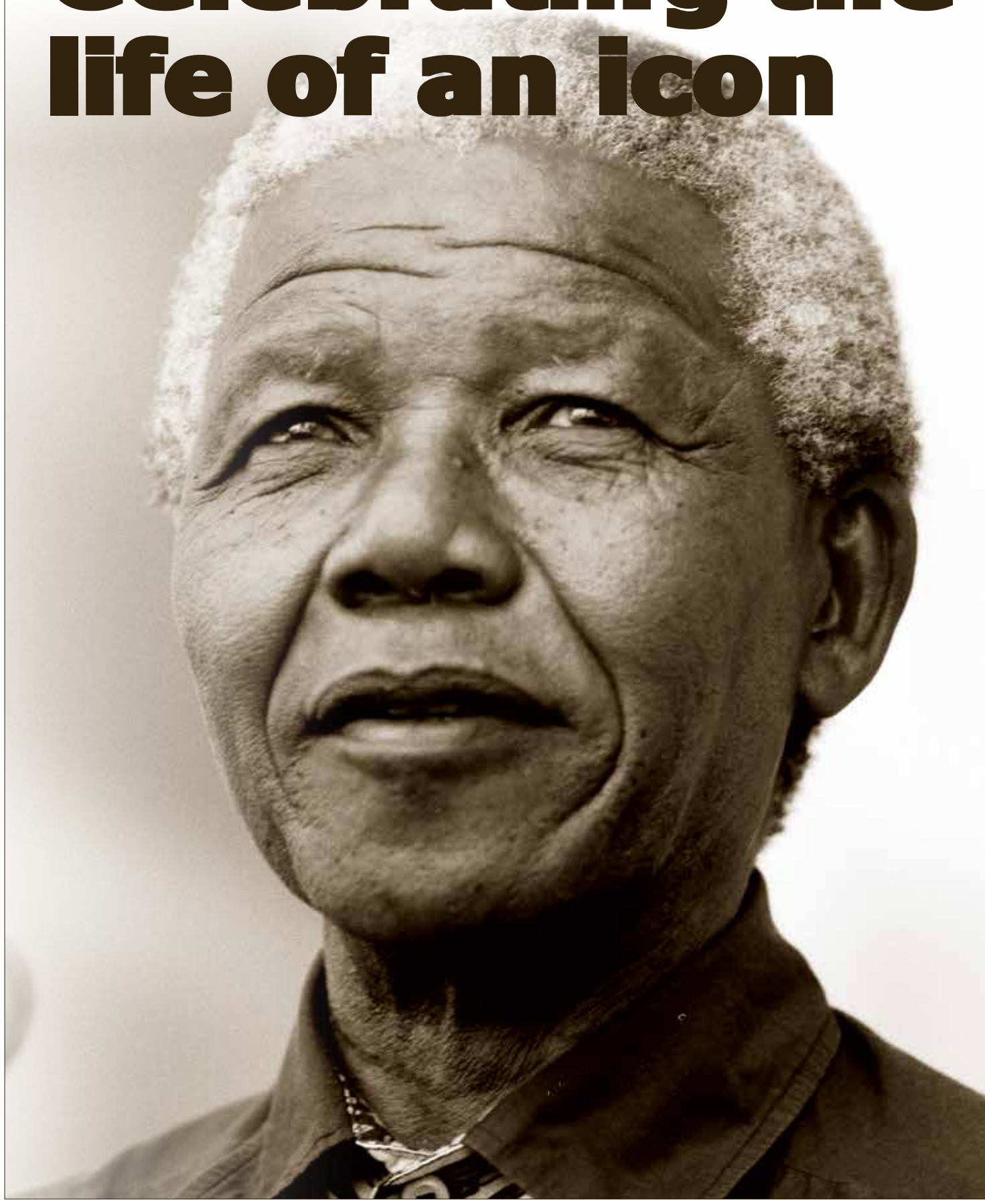

**N**dzawulo ya Vurimi ya Kapa-Vupeladyambu yi fambisa nongonoko lowu wu pfunaka van'wamapurasi lavantshwa na lava se va kotaka ku tiyimela hi endlelo ra nseketelo kusuka eka siku ro sungula – loko va dinga mpfuno hi timali leti nyikiwaka – kufikela loko va kota ku tiyisa emahlweni.

## Young female farmer leads in YAFF awards

**B**eing born with a disability did not stop Landiswa Diniso from achieving her dream of being a farmer. In fact, it encouraged her to work harder.

The 28-year-old is the owner of Landiswa Diniso Livestock Enterprise in Burgersdorp in the northern part of the Eastern Cape.

She walked away with the Special Ministerial Award for a young entrepreneur living with a disability at the recently held 2018 Youth in Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries (YAFF) awards.

Diniso was born with a disability in her left leg and has to wear a brace for support. However, she has not allowed

her disability to limit her.

As a young woman who grew up on a farm and later moved to a township in the Eastern Cape, Diniso said her journey into farming started over three years ago when her uncle gave her a calf.

She kept her calf in a grazing area and in 2015 the same animal which was now a cow had a calf. This inspired the farmer to continue in the farming business and she approached the Department of Rural Development and Agrarian Reform for support. She received animal feed and goats to start her business.

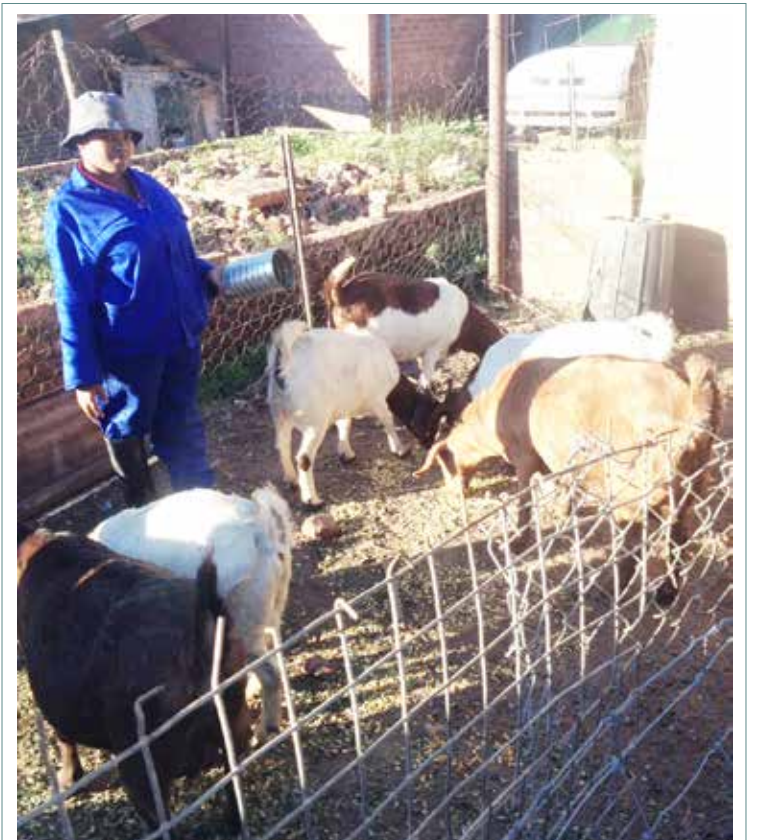
Today, the enterprise has grown to include a herd of 10 cattle, seven goats, eight pigs and a small patch where Diniso plants vegetables for the house-

hold and sells the surplus to the local community. This has become a means of livelihood for Diniso and her family.

She wishes to become a successful livestock farmer in the future and become an inspiration to the younger generation.

With the prize money of R50 000 she said it would help her start her goals. “The prize money will really assist my business. I believe farming is important because it creates job opportunities for unemployed youth,” said Diniso.

Speaking at the awards ceremony, the Minister for Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries, Senzeni Zokwana, said the nominees and recipients of the YAFF awards were proof that the youth is interested in the agriculture sector.

**KUNGU RA NHLUVUKISO** ra Rixaka ri vula leswaku ku simekiwa ka NHI, risima ra xiyimo xa le hansi xa nhlayiso wa rihanyu na ndhurho lowu nga kona wa nhlayiso wa rihanyu lowu nga riki wa mfumo swi dinga ku lulamisiwa.



**H**olobye wa Rihanyu Dok Aaron Motsoaledi u vula leswaku Nawumbisi wo Hundzuluxa wa Ndzindzakhombo wa Rihanyu wa Rixaka wu ta antswisa risima ra nhlayiso wa rihanyu eAfrika-Dzonga. Motsoaledi a ri eku vulavuleni ku nga ri khale eka nhlengeletano yo nyika vukoxoko eka van'wamaphephungu laha a ri eku andlani ka Nawumbisi wo Hundzuluxa wa NHI na Nawumbisi wo Hundzuluxa wa Swikimi swa Vutshunguri. Nawumbisi lowu wu ta

khulela ndlela ya mfikelelo wo tala wa nhlayiso wa rihanyu hi NHI.

Nawumbisi lowu i nkandziyiso wa mpafarhuto wa nawu. Milawumbisi yo tala yi pfafarhutiwa hi ndzawulo ya mfumo ehansi ka xileriso xa holobye loyi a faneleke. Nawumbisi lowu wu fanele ku pasisiwa hi Khabinete wu nga si rhumeriwa ePalamende.

Ku andlariwa ka Milawumbisi leyimbirhi swi vula leswaku Afrika-Dzonga yi le kusuhi hi goza rin'we ku fikelela nhlayiso wa rihanyu ra vanhu

hinkwavo leswi swi vulaka leswaku NHI ku nga ri khale yi ta va nawu.

NHI i sisiteme yo nyika timali leyi yi nga ta tiyisisa leswaku vaakatiko hinkwavo va Afrika-Dzonga va nyikiwa nhlayiso wa rihanyu lowu lavekaka swonghasi, swi nga ri na mhaka xiyimo xa vona xa ku thoriwa na vuswikoti bya vona ku hoxa xandla ka swa timali ko kongoma eka nkwama.

Motsoaledi u vule leswaku mfumo wa wu tiva hindlela yo vava ntiyiso wa leswaku vanhu van'wana va tshemba

swoleswo hambiloko ku nga si vulavuriwa hi mayelana na NHI, ku na xidingo xa ku lunghisa sisiteme ya nhlayiso wa rihanyu ya mfumo leyi tsekatekaka kusungula.

U vule leswaku mfumo wa swi vona swiphiso swa risima ra xiyimo xa le hansi na mpfumaleko wa matirhelo lama nga tlangisiki swipfuno eka sisiteme ya nhlayiso wa rihanyu ya mfumo.

Kungu ra Nhluvukiso ra Rixaka, ku vula Motsoaledi, ri swi kombisile hindlela leyi nga kanakanisiki na leswaku eka ku simeka NHI, risima ra xiyimo xa le hansi xa nhlayiso wa rihanyu naswona ndhurho lowu nga kona wa nhlayiso wa rihanyu swi dinga ku lulamisiwa.

Loko mihundzuluxo ya Milawumbisi leyi yi ri karhi yi jekajekisaniwa, ndzawulo yi ta simeka mune wa tiphurojeke ta NHI leti ti nga ta katsa rihanyu ra le xikolweni, rihanyu ra le miehlekotweni, vaimani lava nga na vuyimana lebyi pfilunganeke eka 22 wa swibedhlele leswi khumbekaka na onkholoji (ntivonkukumakaxitshumba), hi mpfuno wo kongoma wa Gauteng na KwaZulu-Natal, hitlhelo ku ri karhi ku nga honisiwi swifundzakulu leswin'wana.

Nakambe Motsoaledi u vule leswaku ndhurho wa nhlayiso wa rihanyu lowu nga riki wa mfumo a wu fikeleleki

eka vaakatiko vo tala, laha khale ka Muavanyisinkulu Sandile Ngcobo a thoriweke hi Khomixini ya Mphikizano ku endla vulavisi bya makete eka ndhurho wa nhlayiso wa rihanyu lowu nga riki wa mfumo.

"Mihundzuluxo leyi hi yi andlalaka yi endleriwa ku nyika mphalalo lowu dingekaka swonghasi eka vavabyi lava tikumaka va ri emaxangwini ya swa timali yo tivikana," a vula.

Motsoaledi u vule leswaku hundzuluxo wo sungula wa Nawumbisi lowu wu ta herisa tihakelo to hakerisana.

Tihakelo to hakerisana swi vula leswaku xikimi xi hakela xiphemu xa bili leyi muphakeri – ku nga va xibedhlele kumbe dokodela loyi a nga riki wa mfumo – a yi koxaka muvabyi. Timali letin'wana hinkwato ti fanele ku hakeriwa hi muvabyi kusuka exikhwameni xa yena.

## Plans to drastically change TB treatment

**THE INTRODUCTION** of Bedaquiline has earned South Africa the top spot as the first country in the world to dispense this type of treatment.

**P**atients with Multi-drug Resistant Tuberculosis (MDR-TB) will now be able to receive life changing treatment as the Department of Health begins its roll-out of Bedaquiline.

According to the department's drug resistant TB director, Norbert Ndjeka Bedaquiline will replace the old regimen, which makes use of injections to administer MDR-TB treatment.

"This means that for the first time, an injection-free

regimen will be recommended for all patients with Rifampicin Resistant Tuberculosis in South Africa. Additionally, patients with MDR-TB will now also receive Bedaquiline as part of a more patient friendly short regimen, which is expected to improve adherence and ensure success," he said.

The introduction of Bedaquiline has earned South Africa the top spot as the first country in the world to dispense this type of treatment.

The department says Be-

daquilline has been hailed for its effective treatment and short turnaround time.

"Treating patients with drug resistant TB was difficult with old medicines, which had many negative side effects and over long periods often up to 24 months."

In addition, the treatment is revered for reducing the number of deaths and having fewer side effects in comparison to its injectable counterpart, which resulted in hearing loss for many MDR-TB patients.



The department began the roll-out of Bedaquiline across the country in July.

"We started the roll-out with facilities that are ready to implement. This will be done in a phase by phase approach. We will then assist

and capacitate those provinces that need assistance," said Ndjeka.

It is anticipated that roll-out across the country will be concluded between the next three to six months.
