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R25 billion for Waterberg development



President Cyril Ramaphosa is taking important steps to ensure that the communities of the Waterberg District Municipality receive water and infrastructure projects which are in line with the District Development Model.

President Cyril Ramaphosa has announced R25 billion for infrastructure projects in the Waterberg District Municipality in Limpopo.

The projects are expected to, among other things, address issues of severe water shortages in the district which is made up of the Bela-Bela, Lephalale, Modimolle-Mookgophong, Mogalakwena and Thabazimbi local municipalities.

Addressing residents at the Shongoane Sports Ground in Lephalale recently, the President said government would in the next five years complete the Moloko Water Resource Project.

During the period, government would also pursue the Waterberg rail-line and build several much-needed schools in various communities in the district.

“We know that the people of this district are confronted with severe unemployment and poverty. We know about the problems of water, electricity, sanitation and roads. We know about access to land,” he said.

Government, he said, was also aware of the poor telecommunications network that frustrates economic development in the area.

“We need to attract investment in the area. We recently held the second SA Investment Conference and we raised R363 billion from private investment,” he said.

A portion of that money was to be invested in the mining district.

“Government will invest R25 billion over the next five years, and that’s a lot of money. Some companies will in this

Nasele ulinge ngawo woke amandlakho ukwenza bona umtjhadwako ungatjhabalali, isehlukaniso singaba sisombululo esihle phakathi kwakho nomlinganako. Isehlukaniso sibudisi begodu siyagandelela ngokomkhumbulo emndenini begodu nekambiso yezomthetho iyindendende ehlanguhlangu umkhumbulo.

Isehlukaniso yikambiso yalokha umtjhado upheliswa ngokomthetho ekhotho yezomthetho. Kunemihlobo emibili yezehlukaniso: isehlukaniso esingaphikiswako – lapho abathetheneko bavumelana ngokuthi isehlukaniso kumele senzeke; nesehlukaniso esiphikiswako – lapho khona abathetheneko bangavumelani ngegadango lesehlukaniso namkha ngemibandela yaso.

U-Josephine Peta, osiKhulu esiLawula zomThetho e-Ofisini leGcwetha eliQalene nezeMindeneni emNyangweni wezo-Bulungiswa nokuThuthukiswa komThethosisekelo, uhlathulula bona ikambiso yesehlukaniso ithoma nasekukhutjwe incwadi ekubizela ekhotho.

incwadi ebizela ekhotho yesehlukaniso, ekhotho ephakamileko namkha yesigodi, namkha bangaya egcwetheni bona libasize ngekambiso yokuphelisa umtjhado. Umlingani othome iinkambiso zesehlukaniso ubizwa bona mmangali bese lo omunye umlingani abizwe bona mmangalelwa, kutjho u-Peta.

U-Peta uhlathulule bona incwadi ekubizela ethotho yesehlukaniso kufuze:

- itjho bona alisekho ithemba lokobana ungalungiseka umtjhado lo,
- yenze indinyana yokwabiwa kwepahla namkha ikatelele ukusebenza kwemibandela ekwavunyelwana ngayo nakwenziwa isivumelwano sokulawula ipahla phakathi kwabalingani

bobabili esatlikitlwa ngaphambi kokuthoma komtjhado, begodu

- ibeke kuhle bona ngiwaphi amalungiselelo azokwenziwa ebantwaneni babalingani, njengokuthi ngubani ozokuhlala nabantwana

“Incwadi ekubizela ekhotho/ idarhifara kufuze itjho bona ummangalelwa unamalanga ali-10 – nangabe uhlala endaweni yinye nommangali, namkha amalanga ama-20 nangabe ababili laba bahla eemfundeni ezihlukeneko, ukuphendula incwadi embizela ekhotho,” utjho wangezelela u-Peta.

Nasele icala livuliwe, incwadi zibuyiselwa kummangali, neku-fuze athumele imitlolo emibili yeencwadezo esisebenzini sekhotho esisendaweni lapho um-

mangalelwa asebenza namkha ahlala khona.

“Isisebenzi sekhotho-ke sona ngokwaso sizokhambisa iincwadezo sizise kummangalelwa besikhuphe nencwadi ekufuze itlikitlwe mmangalelwa njenge-tshwayo lokuqinisekisa bona uzitholileko iincwadezo. Nangabe kunabentwana hlangana, i-Ofisi lokuYelelisa ngezeMindeneni kufuze laziswe,” ubeka njalo u-Peta.

Ngemva kwesikhathi esimalanga alitjhumu namkha ama-20, ummangali angatlolisa isehlukaniso encwadini yekhotho. Esahlukanisweni esiphikiswako, ummangalelwa kufuze aphe-ndule incwadi embizele ekhotho ngokufuna ukwazisa bona ufuna ukukhandela ukuraga kwesehlukaniso.

“Nasele kwenziwe lokho, ummangalelwa kufuze afake isibawo sokuzibilayezwa ngaphasi kwesikhathi esithileko. Ukuzibilayezwa sitatimende lapho khona ummangalelwa aphen-ndula iinsolo ezisencwadini embizele ekhotho. Ngemva kokufakwa kwesibilayezo, ummangali angaphendula esibilayezweni sommangalelwa namkha afake isaziso sokubekelwa ngeqadi kwesibilayezo.

“Indaba le ngemva kwalokho ikhulunywa ekhotho ukwenzela bona kukhutjwe isigwebo,”

ubeka njalo u-Peta nakaphetha indaba le. **V**

Siyini Isehlukaniso Somtjhado Esizenzakalelako?

Ikhotho inikela ngesehlukaniso somtjhado esizenzakalelako nangabe incwadi ekubizela ekhotho/ idarhifara inikelwe munye wabalingani kwaphela yena azange aphen-ndule ngesikhathi abekelwe sona. Kuqakathekile bona ummangali athome ngokwazisa umlinganako ngesifiso sokuphelisa umtjhadwabo, ngombana ummangalelwa angathatha amagadango wokuphikisana nesiqunto sesehlukaniso ngonobangela wokobana unamabanga ezwakalako amenze bona angakghoni ukuphendula idarhifara ngesikhathi ebegade abekelwe sona.

Certified documents now expire after six months

All government departments and its components have been directed to stop the practice of requiring certified copies of documents not older than three months to accompany applications for employment.

This decision follows complaints raised with President Cyril Ramaphosa on social media and through other channels about the requirements for compliance with public sector job applications.

Departments have been ad-

vised to at least accept certified copies of documents submitted with an application for employment that are up to six months old, in those cases where the document certified does not have an expiry date that falls within the six-month period, the Presidency said.

“Government has recognised that the practice to date impacts negatively on job seekers in the current economic climate in South Africa, and that there is a need to reduce the burden on job seekers to submit - with

each separate job application - certified copies of supporting documents (such as academic qualifications, which are not older than three months),” the Presidency said in a statement.

The Presidency said this change will also reduce the workload that the certification of documents creates for the South African Police Service personnel, who will now be able to devote more time to their core function of ensuring that South Africans are and feel safe. **SAnews.gov.za** **V**
