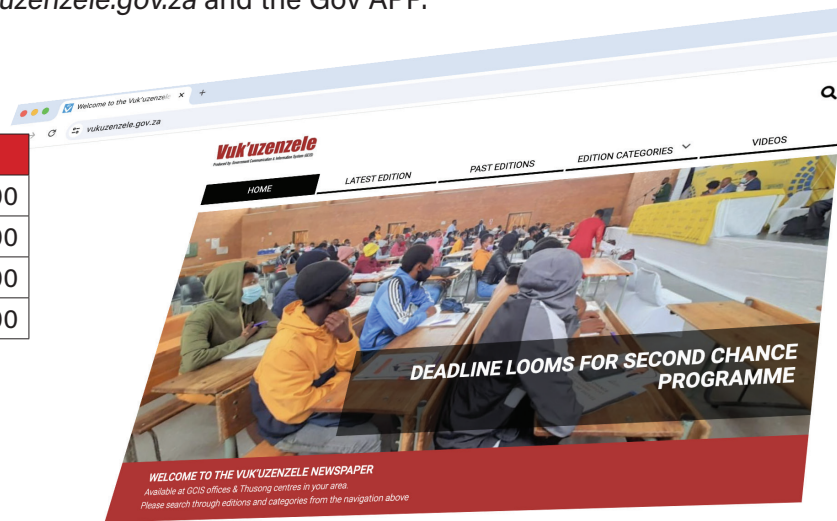


Vuk'uzenzele Rate Card for Government Departments and Entities.

Celestine Khosa's life spiralled into disaster after her mother died on the day she passed her matric about 20 years ago. She checked herself out and got back on her feet after a 10-year "blackout".

"I forgot about my matric and about furthering my education. It started taking care of my own and siblings after her first black-out when my mother died," she told Vukuzenzele in a recent interview.

Today, Khosa holds a Bachelor's Degree in Education and teaches at a school in the North West.

"After 10 years back to schooling with my children, if you don't have a qualification, children take the lift in not wanting to go to school or have a quality education. Not I decided to go back, and I decided to finish my degree in 2022. April '24, Khosa says.
