

Morokotso o o bonwang mo theki-song ya ditlhagiswaa tsa Mokgatlo wa Thoto ya Setshaba (CPA) wa Ravele o arolelwa bajalefa. CPA e tlhomile gape le letlole la dibasari le le thusang baithuti ba le 40 ka matlole kwa di-yunibesithing tse di farologaneng go ralala naga.

Ba ithutela dithuto tse di farologaneng kwa Yunibesithi ya Motsekapa, Yunibesithi ya Kapa Bophirima, Yunibesithi ya Nelson Mandela Metropolitan, Yunibesithi ya Johannesburg, Yunibesithi ya Foreisetata le Yunibesithi ya Sefako Makgatho Health Sciences ka palogothle ya dituelelo tsa bokanaka R410 000 ka ngwaga.

Dakalo Nemauluma ke mongwe wa ba ba neetsweng

basari. O ithutela gerata ya Master of Science ya Chemical Engineering kwa Yunibesithi ya Motsekapa.

Nemauluma a re o leboga thata ka thuso ya matlole ka ntla ya fa a tswa kwa lelapeng le le dikobo dikhutshwane. "Batsadi ba me ga ba dire mme ba nna ba bona ditiro tsa nakwana gangwe le gape go kgona go itshedisa.



Setheo se se bidiwang Balaodi ba Dipolase ba Aforika Borwa (SAFM) se ne se laola polase eno.

Seabe sa setheo se ke go ruta baagi go dirisa lefatshe le ba le busetsweng ka katlego.

Ka 2007, Danie Basson o ne a thapiwa jaaka Mothlankedimogolo wa Ntshodikumo wa SAFM.

Bethuel a re CPA le SAFM ba ne ba sa dumalane mo dintlheng di le mmalwa tebang le tsamaiso ya polase.

CPA e rekisa ditlhagiswaa tsa yona kwa mebarakeng ya Pretoria le Johannesburg (dilitshi).

TO HELP CUT red tape and make it easier to launch a business in South Africa a one-stop-shop concept is being rolled out.

Launching InvestSA President Jacob Zuma said South Africa was open to foreign direct investment which is investors critical to economic growth and job creation.

InvestSA is a one-stop-shop for investors at the Department of Trade and Industry (dti) head office.

"Government is determined

to improve the business environment by lowering the cost ... and improving the ease of doing business."

President Zuma said provincial One Stops would also be launched this year.

"These will be known as InvestSA KZN, InvestSA Gauteng and InvestSA Western Cape and so forth as we roll our new Invest SA brand. Other provinces will open their One Stop Shops over a

period of three years."

Investors get one point of contact

For investors the InvestSA One Stop Shops will be the main point of contact with government. They will help investors to work with the relevant government departments involved in issuing permits and in regulatory, registration, and licensing

Mosola o mogolo wa diritibatsi tse dišwa ke gore ke tsona tse di sa sitweng e bile di nonofile go gaisa melemo e mengwe ya TB.

"E thusa thata, segolo mo baneng, batho ba ba tshwae-tsegileng ka HIV le bolwetse ba sukiri mme ba ke dithophapha tse di botlhokwa tsa balwetse ba gantsi go nnang thata go ba alafa ka katlego."

Tona Motsoaledi o rile lefapha la gagwe le dumelsetswe ke Le-kgotla la Taolo ya Melemo (MCC) go dira gore seritibatsi se se newe balwetse ba nthla ba le 400 kwa Gauteng, KwaZulu-Natal, Bokone Bophirima le Kapa Bophirima jaaka karolo ya porojeke ya ditlhethomiso.

TB e a fola

Ngaka Motsoaledi o rile TB ke bolwetse jo bogolo jo bo bolayang mo malwetseng a a tshwaetsang.

"TB e a fola, segolo fa e tsibogela melemo e bile e lemogilwe go sa le gale."

Le fa go le jalo, re itemogela gape tlhatlogo e e tlhoaetsang ya DR-TB."

O rile DR-TB e tlhatlogile mme e fetisediwa go batho ba ba iseng ba ke ba nne le TB, e leng se se kayang gore MDR-TB e ka bonwa ka tshwaetso ya nthla.

"Go alafa DR-TB ga se fela selo se se bokete, se go nang le kgonagalo e e letobo ya gore se ka alafwa ka katlego, gape

e tlhwatlhwagodimo thata. Ba-thankedi ba Lefapha la Boitekanelo la Bosetshaba ba lekanyetsa gore le fa go dirisiwa bokana ka R400 go alafa molwetse yo a nang le TB, tlhwatlhwab eo e ka menagangwa ga 1 000 go alafa MDR-TB le ga 2 000 go alafa XDR-TB."

Aforika Borwa e kwadisa balwetse ba ka nna 13 000 ba MDR-TB le ba le 1 000 ba XDR-TB ka ngwaga. O rile dntla di le mmalwa di na le seabe mo go siteng melemo ya TB, go akaretsa go lemogwa morago ga sebaka, go se tseye kalafi ka tshwanelo, taolo e e bokoa ya tshwaetso, le tlhokego ya diritibatsi tse dišwa.

Bedaquiline e a dira

"Tsbogo ya melemo go TB gantsi e ikaegile ka diritibatsi tse di ribolotsweng dingwaga di feta 50 tse di fetileng. Ke go sale gale mo seritibatsi se sešwa sa TB, *Bedaquiline*, se neng sa tlhagisiwa.

Aforika Borwa e ne ya reka seritibatsi se ka bonako, mme ga jaana re balelwga go 60% ya

balwetse ba ba amogelang seritibatsi se mo lefatsheng lotlhe."

"Tshedimosetso ya go sale gale e setse e bontsha dipolo tse di botoka mo balwetseng ba le mmalwa ba ba amogelang seritibatsi se, mme katlego ya kalafi e feta 70% fa e bapisiwa le 50% mo go ba ba santseng ba amogela seritibatsi se se tlwaelegileng."

Ngaka Motsoaledi o rile lenaane le ke semphato magareng ga Lefapha la Boitekanelo, Otsuka le Right to Care. Otsuka e leng setlammo sa Japan, e rebola seritibatsi se mahala.

Batho ba ba amiwang ke lero-borobola TB gantsi ke badirameepong, baagi ba mafelo a meepole ba malapa a bona, mafelo a kgopololo, mafelo a a kwa magaeng, baagi ba kwa dipolaseng le dikolo tsa teng mmogo le ditikwatikwe tsa thuto ya motheo.

Ngaka Motsoaledi o rile o solofera fa balwetse kwa Sizwe le maokelo a mangwe go ralala naga ba tla tswelwa mosola ke lenaane le mmogo le maiteko a mangwe a puso e a tsenyang tirisong. □

The business community has welcomed the newly launched InvestSA One Stop Shop initiative.

Derrick Huang, managing director of international company Beyond Your Dreams (BYD) South Africa, says the concept of the one stop shop will make their lives as investors a lot easier.

This Chinese firm is primarily an IT and renewable energy company. It is listed on the Hong Kong and New York stock exchanges and has over 200 000 employees internationally.

"Invest SA is so nice. I know how difficult it is to have your visa or work permit extended in South Africa. This one stop shop will make things so much easier. China and South African relations are at an historical high. We are in the G20 and in Brics there are good things going on between the two countries."

Huang said BYD had big plans for

the South African market especially because BYD was into battery power storage, electric motor vehicles and the manufacturing of cell phones and tablets.

"We have done some business in South Africa. ... We are now really making entrance in South Africa. We are very fortunate to come into the market when things are made much easier for us as investors."

Investors do not need to physically visit the dti to access the One Stop Shop. They can also find information online by visiting www.investsa.gov.za.

Launching InvestSA President Jacob Zuma said The One Stop Shop will provide a more coordinated, streamlined and professional service to those who wish to set up a business," President Zuma. □

processes.

Officials were instructed to keep the service simple and short.

Key departments such as home affairs, labour, environmental affairs, trade and industry and agencies such as the Companies and Intellectual Property Commission (CIPC), South African Revenue

Service and Eskom amongst others will be available at the One Stop Shops.

President Zuma said: "Business people have outlined the difficulties and hassles they face when wanting to establish new businesses, both local and foreign investors." The President also said the CIPC has rolled out self-service terminals in banks,

local economic development agencies and chambers of commerce offices for company registrations. By June this year self-service terminals will be rolled out to all provinces.

President Zuma said the the One Stop Shop's success will depend on the support of all stakeholders in the three spheres of government. □
